**Winemakers Tasting Notes:** From one of Santa Barbara Counties great growing regions, the Rusack 2009 Solomon Hills Pinot Noir captures some of this region's classic characteristics. This wine contains notes of warm allspice, sour cherry, and dried cranberries, which follow through on the palate. The sweet silky tannins make for a round and approachable wine that is also age worthy.

**Optimum Storage Conditions:** Constant temperature, 55-58° F, darkness.  
**Aging Potential:** To enjoy young fruit aromas, consume within 1 to 3 years of bottling date. For extended aging under ideal conditions, consume within 3-7 years of bottling date.

**Fermentation:** Fermented in 1 ton macro bins.  
**Aging:** 100% French oak (50% new) for 10 months.
